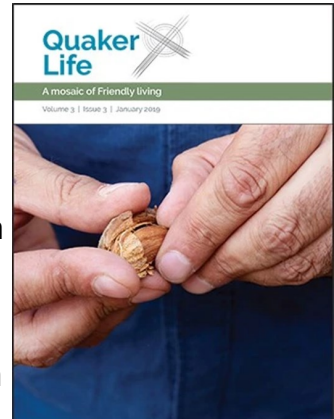
There's always something to do at camp. From picking up sticks to building picnic tables, they can always use the help. Contact the camp office to volunteer: 574-834-4193.
