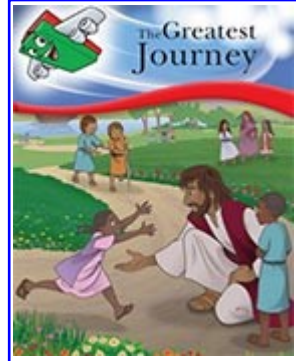

**United Society of Friends Women International (USFW) Joy Circle**

The 2021 USFWI Projects include:

**Belize Pastoral Minister**, Oscar Mmbali, leads the Friends Church in Belize City, works with police/neighborhood relations and on ending human trafficking to bring more peaceful conditions to the area. \$4,000.

**Cuba: Quaker Institute of Peace**, FUM and Earlham School are partnering with Cuban Friends to provide practical training in peace building and conflict resolution from a Quaker perspective to equip Latin American Quakers with tools they need to reduce violence in their communities. \$1,000.
