Talk at First Friends of Indianapolis

Joe Roberts, retired attorney and Quaker from Noblesville Friends, will speak on D.C. Stephenson of the KKK and the Indiana trial that helped bring down the Klan in the 1920s. Joe's father, Justin Roberts, was Hamilton Co. prosecutor at the time of the famous trial that convicted Stevenson of murder. The aftermath of the trial helped rid Indiana of corrupt politicians and aided in drastically reducing Klan membership across the country. This is a fascinating story, told from a Quaker perspective, about local history that impacted the nation in the 1920s when Indiana was a stronghold of the KKK, a hate group which still exists today.
